**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Borough of Flemington Planning Board, County of Hunterdon and State of New Jersey has scheduled a Joint Meeting with the Borough of Flemington Historic Preservation Commission to hold a public hearing on revisions to the official map of the Flemington Historic District. More specifically, changes to the designation of 3 properties is proposed, including 19 Church Street (change to Non-Contributing Historic/Contemporary), 70-74 Main Street (change to Non-Contributing Historic/Contemporary) and 20-22 East Main Street (change to Non-Contributing Historic/Contemporary). These changes reflect the fact that the historic structures at 19 Church Street and 20-22 East Main Street were destroyed by fire and also reflect new construction associated with the Courthouse Square project at 70-74 Main Street. Copies of the revisions to the official map of the Flemington Historic District and Memorandum from the Borough of Flemington Historic Preservation Commission Consultant are available for review in Borough Hall at the address below.

This joint meeting will take place at the regular meeting of the Planning/Zoning Board on Tuesday, June 9, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at Borough Hall located at 38 Park Avenue, Flemington, New Jersey, 08822. This meeting will also be offered virtually via the 'Zoom Webinar' internet platform.
