SUBJECT: RESOLUTION 2023-38: SUPPORT OF PROPOSED SENATE

BILL NO. 861 ALLOWING MUNICIPALITIES TO CONDUCT ANNUAL EVENT FOR OPEN BURING OF CHRISTMAS TREES

SUGGESTED ACTION:

WHEREAS, for many years, numerous municipalities in New Jersey hold annual holiday gatherings where open burnings (bonfires) are conducted using discarded Christmas trees under the watchful eyes of local Fire Departments; and

WHEREAS, Great music, food, and entertainment for children served as an excellent complement to the bonfire on a cold winter night; and

WHEREAS, these events are enjoyed by thousands of residents over the years and are wonderful community events for all that attend; and

WHEREAS, by holding these successful events, it also allowed the municipalities to utilize the trees as fuel for the bonfire rather than have taxpayers fund the cost to have them disposed of through traditional solid waste means and be brought to a landfill; and

WHEREAS, many years ago, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Air Quality (NJDEP) advised municipalities that opening burning events where Christmas trees were utilized were now prohibited as they considered these trees "rubbish", which was prohibited from being burned in this fashion; and

WHEREAS, since the inception of this enforcement action by NJDEP, municipalities are no longer able to burn Christmas trees at

annual holiday events and are forced to utilize other material that is not deemed "rubbish" by the NJDEP, as well as pay to have the discarded trees disposed of; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 861 is being considered by the New Jersey Legislature that permit NJDEP to establish rules, regulations, and standards for the open burning of Christmas trees by municipalities within the State, and would permit municipalities to conduct annual events for open burning of Christmas trees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Flemington support the bill being proposed in order to ensure that the municipalities in the State are permitted to hold annual holiday bonfire fueled by discarded Christmas trees in a safe and enjoyable manner.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Governor Murphy, Senate President, Assembly speaker, DEP Commissioner and Conference of Mayors.

WHEREAS, Flemington Borough requires fire inspections of commercial and residential properties in the borough, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Marshal is recommending the re-appointment of Stephen Eckert and Alan Umgelter as Deputy Fire Marshals to conduct fire inspections for the Borough at a rate of \$22.01 per hour in 2023; and

WHEREAS, the licensing fees generated by the inspections will cover the expense with no negative impact to any other aspect of the Borough budget or financial commitment to the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Eckert and Mr. Umgelter are fully certified by the State of New Jersey as Fire Officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Flemington re-appoints Stephen Eckert and Alan Umgelter as Deputy Fire Marshals as part-time per diem Deputy Fire Marshals at a rate of \$22.01 per hour from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Borough of Flemington is hereby authorized to enter into said agreement with Remington & Vernick Engineers; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of this Resolution shall be published as required by law; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available in the 2023 budget, various capital ordinances, and various escrow accounts.
